**Re:** Indaver to submit Industrial Emissions licence application & Environmental Impact Assessment Report to the Environmental Protection Agency

We are writing to inform you that we intend to submit an Industrial Emissions licence application and an Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in the coming weeks. The EPA is the competent authority for granting and enforcing Industrial Emissions licences in Ireland.

The application relates to our proposed Resource Recovery Centre in Ringaskiddy which received planning permission on May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018. The project is currently the subject of a judicial review process and we expect a decision from the High Court this year.

An Industrial Emissions licence is required under EU law, specifically the Industrial Emissions Directive (IED). As part of our planning permission, we are obliged to obtain a licence in advance of construction and operation of the Resource Recovery Centre.

The IED takes an integrated approach to environmental protection which is aimed at protecting the environment as a whole. We fully support this approach to robust environmental monitoring and have been successfully operating a waste-to-energy facility in Duleek, Co. Meath since 2011.

We intend to erect a notice at our Ringaskiddy site and place an advertisement in local newspapers prior to submission of the application and EIAR. The EPA will make these documents available on its website once it has validated the application. We will also make these documents available at [www.ringaskiddyrrc.ie](http://www.ringaskiddyrrc.ie) and will advise you once the documents are available on both websites.
